**EXAMINATION –CUM PROMOTION POLICY FOR CLASSES I-VIII**

- Each student of class I to V must get a minimum D grade in each subject and a minimum if 4.0 Cumulative grade Point Average ( CGPA) in order to be eligible for promotion to the next higher class.
- The entire academic year is divided in two term ie "April to September " and "October to March". AccordingLy the syllabus for each subject is divided in in two terms ie .50% each in both terms. The syllabus for Term 1 is not assessed in Term 2.
- Each term includes two Formative Assessments (FA) and one Summative Assessment (SA) as per the detail given below:

Grand Total = 50% of Term 1 + 50% Term 2 = 100/ Weight age.

- Each Formative Assessment includes the following component:

Class Test	10 Marks
Class Response	10 Marks
Assignments	10 Marks
Activity based Assessment (Debate, Quiz, Project, Survey, Seminar, etc)	10 Marks

The average of these four components will give marks out of 10.

5. (a) No Grace Marks will be given to any student.
- (b) Those student who have participated at National level or secured position at state level during the academic session and have failed to secure 'D' grade in any subject their performance will be upgraded by one grade in that subject only.
- (c) Those student who have secured first/second/third position in games at national level and have failed to secure 'D' grade in upto two subject, their performance will also be upgraded by one grade in those Subject(s)
6. In case a student has missed any of the Summative Examination in any subject(s) on Medical grounds /sports movement/Offical Movement /Authorised level sanctioned by the Principal & Director only, will be eligible for promotion to the next class based on his/her performance in the other Summative Assessment Examination in the respective subject(s) . In such cases, the due weightage based on the other Summative Assessment in those subject will be given to student.
7. A minimum of 75% physical attendance in the school is mandatory for a student to appear in the final exam.
